Financial details are attached. This year we made a small loss compared with the previous period. Subscriptions down \$455. The invoice for our member levy fee that we pay to the federation always arrives around the 31 March which is the same time as we prepare our final accounts. It would appear this was not included in the previous year's report. This year the levy was \$921. We have total Equity of \$63,458. This is made up of funds in current account \$23477 and \$39981 in Term Deposits.

The accounts have been reviewed by Mr George Tuffin of Eastbourne. I would like to thank Mr Tuffin for this work

We are fortunate to have this amount of funds on hand and thank the founding members for this Nest Egg. I understand when SeniorNet Hutt City was founded in 1999 there were approximately 600 Members and the Learning Centre was in a space off the Waterloo Railway Station and we weren't charge any rent. We have in the past applied for grants. One year we were lucky enough to be granted 2 years rent which was a great help. Our lease expired at the end of May this year and after a battle with the owners which we lost our rent went up \$720 per year. We are now paying \$14,398 Incl GST per year.

Our current membership is 144. We thank all members past and present for supporting SeniorNet Hutt City over the years.

I took over as Treasurer from Bill Beard in 2018 and have now decided to hand the responsibility over to a new Treasurer who will be voted on this AGM

I now move that the annual accounts be accepted has a true and correct record of the year's transactions.
